### EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS FOR LANGUAGE TESTS IN FRENCH

| French and bilingual programs   |   |

| University programs (BAMgt and Short Program)   | Have studied full-time in French at the secondary (Cycle 2) or post-secondary level for two complete and consecutive years  |
| College programs (DCS and ACS) <sup>1</sup>   | Have completed high school studies in French in Quebec or at an institution that operates under the ministry of National Education in France  |
| Vocational training programs<br>Cuisine and Gastronomy (DVS)  |   |
| Vocational training programs<br>Professional Pastry Making (DVS)<br>International Service and Sommelier Training (DVS and AVS)<br>Advanced Culinary Arts (AVS)<br>Plant-Based Food and Cooking (ITHQ Diploma) | Have obtained a secondary school diploma (SSD) in Quebec from a recognized educational institution<br><b>OR</b><br>Have completed high school or post-secondary education in French<br><b>OR</b><br>Have completed Level 8 of the <a href="#">Quebec government's French-language courses</a> |
