Financial aid for hosting an intern

Internships in Quebec

Note: The necessary attestations will be sent to you automatically by the ITHQ, no later than six months after the end date of the internship.

1. Revenu Québec : <u>Crédit d'impôt pour stage en milieu de travail - étudiant inscrit à temps plein dans un établissement d'enseignement reconnu</u> (in French only)

A company can claim a tax credit ranging from 30% to 50% for on-the-job training.

Eligible levels of study: vocational, college and university

Revenu Québec : Act to promote workforce skills development and recognition
 Expenses incurred by hosting interns can be included in the calculation of the 1% of payroll dedicated to training.

Eligible levels of study: vocational, college and university

Internships in Canada

Note: International students are not eligible for these programs.

1. Fédération des chambres de commerce du Québec : Accueillez un stagiaire Program

The grant is available to employers located in Canada, private and not-for-profit, French and English speaking, of all sizes and in most industries. Businesses that welcome at least one intern to their team are eligible for a wage subsidy of up to \$7,500.

Eligible levels of study: vocational, college and university

2. Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC): Canada Summer Jobs Program

This program offers a **wage subsidy** to encourage employers to create quality summer jobs for young people aged 15 to 30.

Applicable levels of study: college and university

3. Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) & Tourism HR Canada: Propel program

Eligible employers can receive a wage subsidy of up to \$7,000 for each student hired under the program.

Eligible levels of study: college and university

4. Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC): <u>Student work placement program powered by</u>

Magnet

By hiring a student for a work-based learning experience (WLE), you may be eligible for a **grant of up to \$7,000**.

Eligible levels of study: college and university
